A vital part of the ministry of Christ Church is the Episcopal Day School with over 400 students from age 2 to 8th grade.

Christ Church Parish is committed to creating a welcoming and supportive environment for all youth. The Director of Youth Ministry engages with and supports students of all backgrounds and orientations.

The Director of Youth Ministry will be responsible for casting and implementing a vision for ministry for and with the youth of Christ Church i.e., grades 6-12. The Director of Youth Ministry will develop and oversee a team of volunteers to form the youth of our community with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Cast a vision for youth ministry at Christ Church.
- Recruit, train, and support a team of youth leaders.
- Maintain and publicize a calendar of youth activities including formation, fellowship, and outreach.
- Effectively communicate with youth and parents.
- Organize Christian Education on Sunday morning (Sunday School).
- Attend weekly staff meetings (Tuesday mornings) and regular Sunday services.
- Engage with the Episcopal Day School to build relationships with students.
- May occasionally teach Christian Ed and lead chapel services. This position is not responsible for these activities but will be involved.
