ARE YOU A
"COMMUNICANT IN GOOD STANDING"
AT CHRIST CHURCH?

We often encounter someone who worships with us on a week to week basis and later learn that they have never officially "joined" the parish. What does it mean to be a "communicant in Good Standing?" Now, of course, all baptized believers who have been fully grafted into the Body of our Lord, can participate in our ministries and receive the sacraments, but the Church also believes and continues to believe, that an adult and public affirmation of faith in Christ and a commitment to His Church is very important. What does this mean?

Specifically, can you remember a time when a Bishop of the Episcopal Church laid his hands on you and either "confirmed" or "received" you into the Episcopal Church? If so, and it did not happen at Christ Church, then your "letter of membership" is likely at the parish where this DID happen. You need to contact Kelly Heindl at the Church office and ask her to transfer your membership TO Christ Church. If NOT, then you are likely listed as a Baptized Member, but you are not a "Communicant in Good Standing." This means that you need to attend the required preparation classes (deemed "Christ Church 101") and have the Bishop lay his hands on you at our public service during his annual visitation to be held on June 6th of this year. If you have not officially been received or confirmed, please contact Kelly Heindl here at the Church and plan to attend and participate in the spring "Christ Church 101" Class which begins on Sunday, February 14.

Note that the official definition of a "Communicant in Good Standing" is a person 16 years or older who "...for the previous year have been faithful in corporate worship, unless for good cause prevented, and have been faithful in working, praying, and giving for the spread of the Kingdom of God..." (Title I, Canon 17: section 3 of the Constitution and Canons of The Episcopal Church). We hope this clears up any confusion and if you have any questions, please feel free to give us a call. JR. EYC (6th-8th grade)

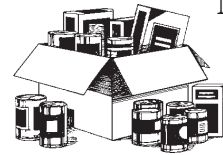
