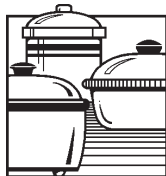

Facts about the Christ Church Youth Group:

- 2009 Mission Trip: Over 25 helped to renovate 53 houses and hundreds of lives
 - Raised funds to sponsor 5 turkeys and helped with the YAF Meal for the Homeless
 - Donating \$201.62 from our pockets for Haiti and several hundred from our department
 - On average:
 - 20-25 Club 45 (4th-5th) monthly
 - 5-10 Jr. High weekly on Sunday
 - 10-15 Jr. High weekly on Wednesday
 - 15-20 Sr. High weekly on Wednesday
 - 7 Sr. High went on “Happening #51,” most from any church in the Diocese
 - Sr. High Youth unanimously agreed to donate 10% of everything we raise through fundraising directly back to Christ Church

JR. EYC (6th-8th grade)

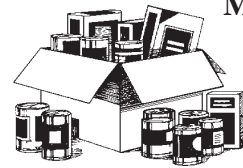
Wed afternoon Bible Study: Weekly Bible Study program from 2:30-4:00 in the Undercroft at Christ Church; continues through Lent.
