(Honor your mother and father; Honor life)

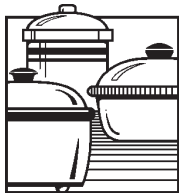
**March 17** — Commandments VII-VIII

**JR. EYC (6th-8th grade)**

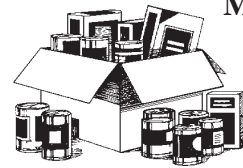
*Wed afternoon Bible Study:* Weekly Bible Study program from 2:30-4:00 in the Undercroft at Christ Church; continues through Lent.
