"The Gospel and Harry Potter" will be the theme for our Wednesday night Lenten series this year. Author J. K. Rowling's amazingly popular series of "Harry Potter" books for young people contain many themes that are central to our faith such as: a theology of good vs. evil; loyalty and sacrificial love towards one's friends; how one follows what is good when making complex ethical decisions; and what is justice in the midst of systems that have become corrupted by sin? If you have never read a "Harry Potter" book or seen one of the films, you will find that life at Hogwarts School will be easy to understand! Each week we will have a presentation by Fr. Neal Goldsborough followed by table discussions. These classes are meant for parishioners of all ages. Young people who have read the books are especially welcome! A covered dish supper begins at 5:45 PM with the classes following at 6:15-7:15. Please note that this year there will not be a Eucharist before the supper.
