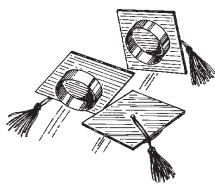

## VESTRY NOTES — JULY 10, 2008

~ *Summer Months Filled with Activity* ~

Father Harry Hill reported that a committee of the vestry to serve as a liaison between the vestry and Children and Youth Ministries has been formed and has held their kick-off meeting. Those serving on the committee are Sr. Warden Bruce Partington, Jr. Warden Walt Kindergan, Lola Hogeman and Lucy Rentz. The committee will work with staff and volunteers who are involved with children and youth, including EDS, to ensure that policies and procedures are in place which adhere to the vestry's expectations and responsibilities.

Sr. Warden Bruce Partington reported that the final repairs on the church campus are proceeding on schedule and that the roof tiles should be delivered in three weeks. "Absent any unforeseen problems, the work should be completed by the beginning of the school year," Partington said.

Noting other maintenance work being done, Jr. Warden Walt Kindergan reported that painting continues around the church with the vesting room being painted and new carpet installed. He said a committee of ECW volunteers headed by Doris Gaines is working on refurbishing of the parlor. New carpet and upholstering of furniture should have the parlor looking much better.

Rob Dixon reported on the mission trip to Mt. Vernon, IL, a small town near Chicago. Christ Church youth and adult chaperones working with other youth from around the United States helped repair fifty houses for those in need. Dixon said the experience for the Christ Church group was "truly transforming."

Treasurer Ray Jones presented an upbeat report stating that the Sunday, July 6 offering was at \$22,000 and expenses continue to be under budget.

## VOLUNTEER FOR CAMP CARE

The Diocesan Commission on World Missions is providing a Diocesan-wide outreach opportunity for those who cannot, for whatever reason, travel to our companion Diocese of the Dominican Republic for mission work. They are requesting your help in getting the word out about an outreach mission opportunity, Camp Coast Care, a social ministry of Lutheran Episcopal Services in Long Beach, Mississippi.

Beginning as an emergency distribution center and medical care facility immediately after Hurricane Katrina, the camp now focuses on reconstruction of the Mississippi Gulf Coast. During the course of a week, volunteers are given meaningful work in restoring and rebuilding homes. To date, volunteers have used their time and energy to rehabilitate over 350 homes destroyed by Hurricane Katrina. Experts have estimated that it will take a minimum of ten years to reconstruct and recover from all the damage.

While construction skills are extremely valuable to this effort, all volunteers, whether skilled or not are needed. Unskilled volunteers are needed for the camp kitchen, camp operations, or are trained and given jobs to do at the construction sites. There are two weeks remaining in the schedule allowed to us, and a need for 35 plus volunteers for each of the weeks. A suggested donation of \$20 per volunteer per night is recommended and allows the camp to use all its resources for rebuilding. Room and board are provided.

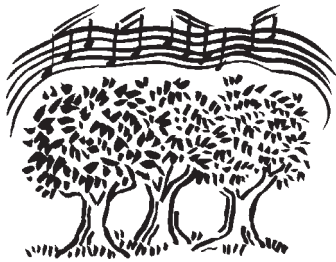
