- When will the retreat start and end?  
Camp will be available for check in beginning at 4:00pm on Friday, Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup>. The retreat will begin with a hospitality hour at 5:00pm that evening and dinner beginning at 6:00pm. The retreat will conclude on Sunday, Sept. 24<sup>th</sup> with Eucharist at 9:15am.
